Application Advice

Acrygen 61192 self-crosslinking acrylic binder provides firm hand properties and moldability to nonwovens and textiles.

Shipping and Storage

This product is supplied in road tankers or in non-returnable plastic drums or in totes (IBC). The product must be protected from frost and exposure to direct sunlight. Storage temperatures between +5 °C and +30 °C are recommended. Care must be taken that drums and containers are properly closed. During storage, shipping and handling contact with metal surfaces that are not corrosion protected must be avoided. When stored properly, the product has a shelf life of 12 months from the date of delivery. This product is not freeze-thaw stable.

Mix the contents thoroughly before sampling. Product may undergo accelerated thickening with increased heat. Avoid prolonged storage at high temperatures.
